How To Get Emergency Food from a Pantry

Make sure you income qualify: To access an emergency food pantry your household income must be at or below 185% of the federal poverty level. Refer to the chart at the right.

You will not need to show <u>any</u> identification to access food from a Lane County pantry. Some of our partner agencies provide other services and may require other documentation for those services, but never to receive emergency food.

Bring boxes/bags: Please make sure to bring enough bags or boxes to take your food with you. You will be able to receive a 3-5 day supply of food for your household.

You may have to wait: Sometimes lines can be long. Get to know your home pantry system and personnel to best understand how each pantry works.

You are welcome to get involved: Many pantries would love your help. Ask personnel if they are looking for volunteers - it's a great way to give back!
